



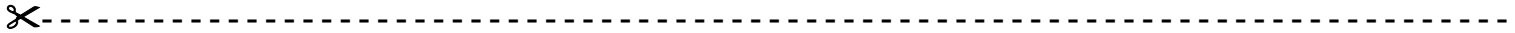
NDSWRA's Mission:

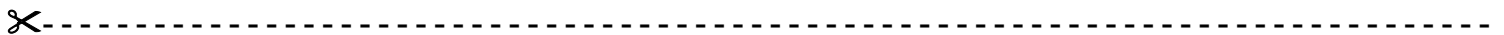
