Our Organization

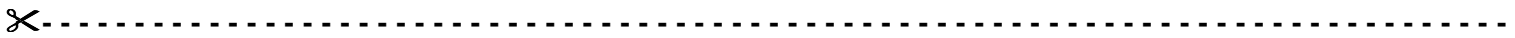
